- 2. Submit a science test score. The following test scores may be submitted for membership:

90% on Iowa, Stanford, or Terra Nova Science Section ACT Science Test – 26 or higher AP Science test - 4 or 5 score CLEP Science test - 68 or higher SAT 2 Test – 600 or higher

A. Online testing may be used if the test is given at a testing center or at a private tester's facility. Parents must not have access to the student, computer, or test materials while the test is being administered. Students

may not have access to other electronic devices which may connect to the internet, email, or texting during testing.

- B. Test scores should not be more than 1 year old.
- C. All tests must be administered in a group setting if a parent is helping with the test administration. If a group setting is not possible, a non-family member may administer the test in a one-on-one setting, as long as the parent does not have access to the test. **Parent administered tests are not acceptable.**
- 3. A short statement about why you would like to be a member of the NHSSHS
- 4. A letter of recommendation from your parent(s).
- 5. Three letters of recommendation from someone other than your parent(s). These may be e-mailed to spowell@hepbookstore.com.

To remain active, students must submit 20 verified hours of service/inservice each year. The service record form will be available at <a href="www.nhsshs.org">www.nhsshs.org</a> once the web page is launched this fall. Until then, please track your own hours and have your sponsor/supervisor sign off on them. Failure to submit the service-hours form will result in a forfeiture of membership.

Graduating seniors are eligible to order a NHSSHS Diploma of Graduation from the HEP Bookstore. Students may also order an honor cord and NHSSHS shawl for graduation.
